Evidence-Based Nursing Practice Workshop (with assessment)

Background:

Contemporary nursing takes place in the midst of an environment characterized by increasing healthcare choices, rising expectations, constrained resources, and increasing complexity of health care delivery. Furthermore, with increasing advances in biomedical and clinical research providing unprecedented insights into health promotion and disease prevention, nurses face the challenge of having to utilize findings of well designed research studies and translate them effectively into everyday practice.

Learning Objectives: Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to

- Understand the basic concepts of quantitative and qualitative research;
- Identify clinical issues or problems requiring evidence-based practice;
- Identify potential innovations for improving patient outcomes or quality of care;
- Develop evidence-based practice guidelines or protocols;
- Critically appraise the evidence in order to determine its certainty and applicability;
- Assessing the implementation potential of an evidence-based innovation;

• Implement the evidence-based nursing practice in clinical settings.
